

Minervois, Languedoc

Paguignan, 30km Narbonne
Two cottages

(each sleep 4)



These two spacious and very tasteful dwellings are within an outbuilding of the owners' substantial house, formerly the Maison de Maître of a viticulteur, and within the west wing, Cottage A, the "Ecurie", is on three floors and has an agreeable garden patio shown in lower drawing, with table and 4 chairs (not 5!) and the dappled shade from 3 acacia trees. From this patio, and from the pergola terrace of Cottage B, one has an agreeable view of the steep hillside where the owners possess some tangled terraces, once, in Roman times, a garden, where as serious botanists, they experiment with unusual species. The view from their garden is seen above.

Accommodation in both cottages includes 2 bedrooms (1 double, 2 single beds), bathroom (A bath, B shower), central heating. They have the use of a washing machine, and are both most attractively decorated and furnished, and invested with a certain magic.
