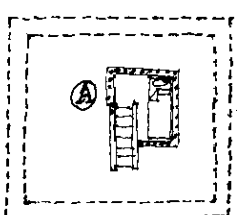


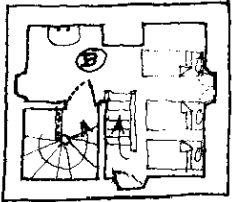

with own POOL

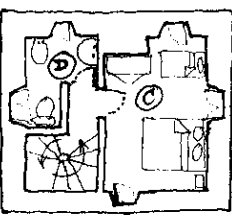

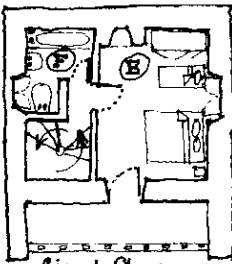
fourth level



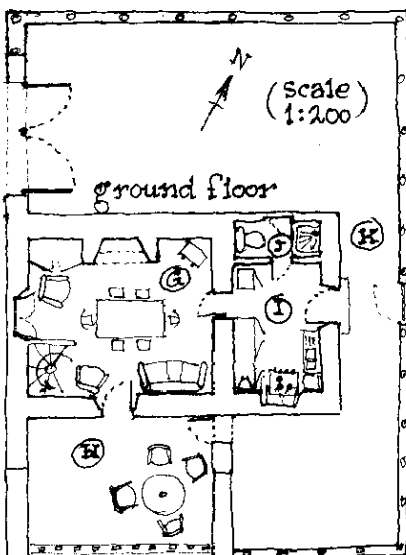
third floor

Accommodation includes 3 bedrooms *B C E* plus gallery *A* above *B*, with fine panoramic views. Bedding includes two double beds, 2/3 single beds *B* plus mattress *A*, two cots, plus sofa-bed *G*. One bath *F*, one shower *J*, two WCs *D J*, 3 basins. The living room opens to patio *H* (garden furniture) overlooking ornamental or farm pond. Washing machine is in kitchen *I*.

Terms: rental runs from 18 hours on day of arrival to noon on day of departure. Terms include energy in high season. Bed linen is available on request.

This most unusual house, awarded in 1981 the Tarbes prefect's prize for outstanding restoration, and recently improved by the addition of a 5m x 10m pool, situated to side of house, stands on the brow of a vineyard belonging to the owners, whose home is about 100 metres from the house, at a distance of 1km from the village of Madiran (all basic shops – butcher, baker, grocer, supermarket – market on Tuesdays, and tennis courts, also a restaurant). The house is 12km north of Maubourguet, the local market town, 40km north of Tarbes, the “préfecture” or administrative centre of the Hautes Pyrénées département and 58km from Lourdes, and is thus within easy reach by car of the very fine Pyrénées mountains (unlimited scope for walking and climbing), clearly visible from the house in clear weather (the mountains subject to cloud).
